ELIGIBILITY



Current PEER or Alumni enrolled in college or vocational training

Can Apply no more than 2 times in a 12 month period

Participant completes an application and attaches documentation of the financial need.

PROCESS

Applications are reviewed by the youth engagement team and sent to Cynthia Oberkofler for approval.

If approved, payments to schools or purchases are coordinated through Millhill.
